A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR TYLER EXECUTIME SOFTWARE AND THE BIOMETRIC TIME AND ATTENDANCE SYSTEM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$125,228.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in line with the City's Strategic Plan of providing excellent municipal services and a high performing City organization providing great customer services, the City needs to purchase ExecuTime Prox Readers and increase the ExecuTime Time & Attendance licenses for the administration; and

WHEREAS, the City's application and allow for electronic collection and tracking accurate workforce data, thus streaming the payroll process. This integration will reduce and eliminate dual entry between timekeeping and payroll, avoids managing two sets of security, and eliminates the need to manipulate interface files; and

WHEREAS, ExecuTime Touchscreen 10: Biometrics and Prox Readers will provide the City departments the capability to efficiently track attendance of employees by simplifying the clocking-in and out process with the use of fingerprints; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies is the sole source provider of ExecuTime; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-60 of the City Charter following materials and services shall be exempt from the bidding process and subject to the spending limitations provided in subsection 3-3.14, a. Sole source purchases. Sole-source supplies and services, such as unique, patented, or franchised supplies or services, are exempt if the Purchasing Agent determines, after conducting a good faith review of available sources, that the particular supply or service is available from only one (1) source; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-5B6 of the City Charter excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, the Senior IT Manager, the Finance Director and the Human Resources Director recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Tyler Technologies for the purchase of ExecuTime and the Biometric Time and Attendance system in the not to exceed total amount of \$125,228.00 and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Tyler Technologies in the not to exceed total amount of \$125,228.00.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Tyler Technologies, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney, in the not to exceed total amount of \$125,228.00.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
