

**RESOLUTION NO. R2021-XX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ENTERPRISE RENTAL VEHICLES, INCORPORATED FOR THE PURCUREMENT OF RENTAL VEHICLES ESTIMATED BUDGETED AMOUNT OF \$95,655.**

**WHEREAS**, in line with the City of North Miami Beach’s (“City”) Strategic Plan mission of providing excellent municipal services and a being beautiful, safe and livable community in South Florida, the City requires the procurement of rental vehicles for Gang/Fraud Task Force/VIN units; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3-2.2 of the City’s Code of Ordinances provides that the Chief Procurement Officer has the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the City would be served; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coral Springs contract is a solicited purchasing vehicle available to state and local government agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, City of Coral Springs contract was awarded to Enterprise on July 21, 2021. The City of Coral Springs contract with Enterprise is in effect until August 21<sup>st</sup>, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract, Enterprise has provided the City with a pricing list for the different classes of rental vehicles they have available. As outlined in Exhibit A1, the vehicles available in the class IV tier will be most feasible for the police department under cover units; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3-3.14 of the City’s Code of Ordinances provides that contracts in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager, the Chief of Police and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Enterprise for the procurement of rental vehicles in an estimated budgeted amount of \$95,655; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Enterprise for the procurement of rental vehicles, in an estimated budgeted amount of \$95,655.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Commission of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida:

**Section 1.** The aforementioned recitals are true and correct.

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**Section 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Enterprise for the procurement of rental vehicles, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney, in an estimated budgeted amount of \$95,655.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
