RESOLUTION NO. R2022--

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RAZORBACK, LLC TO PERFORM WATER STORAGE TANK CLEANING; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXPEND THE ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE OF \$130,000 AS APPROVED IN THE BUDGET APPROPRIATION PROCESS; PROVIDING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE WITH THE AUTHORITY TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in keeping with the City of North Miami Beach's ("City") Strategic Plan of providing excellent municipal services and being fiscally responsible, the Utilities Department is responsible for maintaining the infrastructure including facilities and buildings at the Norwood-Oeffler Water Treatment Plant ("WTP"); and

WHEREAS, the containment area under the sulfuric acid bulk tank at the WTP requires cleaning and recoating; and

WHEREAS, the City has solicited the assistance of Razorback, LLC ("Razorback") to furnish repair and recoat the sulfuric acid bulk tank to protect it from further deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Palm Beach issued and awarded Invitation to Bid No. ITB-18-19-115 "Water Storage Tank Cleaning and Repair Services" to Razorback, for a three-year term with one additional two-year option to renew, effective May 28, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Palm Beach has executed the option to renew the agreement for a two-year term, extending the contract until May 27, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-4.3 of the City Code allows for the use of other governmental entities' contracts upon a determination that the supplies, materials, equipment, or contractual services needed by the City were purchased using solicitation procedures which are substantially equivalent to the City's Purchasing Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-3.14 of the City Code provides that contracts in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, Utilities Director and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Razorback for the purchase of tank cleaning services at WTP in an estimated amount of \$130,000; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Razorback for the tank

cleaning services at WTP in an estimated budgeted amount of \$130,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Commission of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager or designee to enter into an agreement with Razorback, LLC for the tank cleaning services at Norwood-Oeffler Water Treatment Plant in an estimated budgeted amount of \$130,000.

Section 3. The Mayor and City Commission also authorize the City Manager or designee to do all things to effectuate this resolution provided that any contract is reviewed by the City Attorney for legal sufficiency.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
