

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH REXEL, USA, INC. INCREASING THE CONTRACT BY AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$70,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; SUBJECT TO THE BUDGET APPROPRIATION AND AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Broward County awarded Contract OPN2124942B1_5 “Electrical/Electronic Supplies” (“Piggyback contract”) to Rexel, USA, Inc. (“Rexel”) for a one-year period effective December 6, 2022, through December 5, 2023, with the option to renew for four (4) additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS, an estimated budgeted amount of \$450,000 for the one-time purchase to replace failing Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) along with an estimated annual budgeted amount of \$145,000 for the purchase of various Allen Bradley and Rockwell Automation equipment and specialized services to maintain daily operations at the Norwood Water Treatment Plant, for a total budgeted amount of \$595,000 with Rexel, was previously approved by Commission via Resolution R2024-35 on February 20, 2024; and

WHEREAS, NMB Water continues to conduct routine annual preventive maintenance services at the Norwood Water Treatment Plant. Upon assessment, there are several critical components that require replacement and/or servicing, including, but not limited to, installation and servicing of the VFD for the Reverse Osmosis High Pressure Pumps and the Interstage Booster Pump, at an estimated annual cost of \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-3.20 of the Code of Ordinances City of North Miami Beach, Florida, 2008 (“Code”) requires that change orders exceeding 10% or \$50,000.00, whichever is less, shall be approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute a Change Order to the previously approved contract with Rexel to increase the previously approved annual expenditure by \$70,000 annually, thereby increasing the total annual expenditure to an amount not to exceed \$215,000; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute a Change Order to the previously approved contract with Rexel to increase the previously approved expenditure by \$70,000 annually, thereby increasing the total annual expenditure to an amount not to exceed \$215,000 for Allen Bradley and Rockwell Automation equipment and specialized services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Change Order, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit “A,” to the previously approved contract with Rexel USA, Inc. to increase the annual expenditure by \$70,000, thereby increasing the total annual expenditure to an amount not to exceed \$215,000, for Allen Bradley and Rockwell Automation equipment and specialized services, subject to budget appropriation and availability of funds is hereby approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
