

**RESOLUTION NO. R2025-XX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RANKING OF THE THREE (3) MOST HIGHLY QUALIFIED FIRMS THAT RESPONDED TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS RFP-24-048-SG SCHOOL ZONE SPEED DETECTION SYSTEM AND MONITORING PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOP-RANKED, MOST-QUALIFIED FIRM AND, IF NEGOTIATIONS ARE UNSUCCESSFUL, WITH THE NEXT HIGHEST RANKED FIRM SUCCESSIVELY, UNTIL AN ACCEPTABLE AGREEMENT CAN BE RECOMMENDED FOR CITY COMMISSION APPROVAL.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 3.3 of the City Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), there shall be a City Attorney or law firm who shall be head of the Office of the City Attorney and shall serve at the pleasure of the City Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2024, the City issued Request for Proposals (“RFP”) RFP-24-048-SG School Zone Speed Detection System and Monitoring Program (“School Zone Speed Detection”), seeking said services for a five (5) year term, to provide the installation, maintenance and administration of a school zone speed detection system and monitoring program for multiple school zones within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, electronic notices were posted on the city’s website and Bidsync.com, sent to over 16,300 potential, local and national firms; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 31, 2025, five (5) responses were received from Altumint, Blue Line Solutions, LLC, Jenoptik Smart Mobility Solution, LLC, RedSpeed, and Sensys Gatso USA; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager established an Evaluation Committee comprised of Police Captain of the City of North Miami Beach and two Lieutenants from the Town of Golden Beach and Lieutenant City of Sunny Isles Beach, respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, the Procurement Management Department conducted an administrative review of the submissions and deemed all submissions responsive. On March 27, 2025, at a publicly advertised meeting, the Evaluation Committee submitted an initial scoring of the responses. The Evaluation Committee conducted a public discussion, regarding the established evaluation criteria, including but not limited to: Qualification of Professional Personnel, Project Approach & Understanding, Past Performance and Price; and

**WHEREAS**, a recommendation of the three (3) highest ranked respondents is:

- 1<sup>st</sup> RedSpeed
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Altumint
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Blue Line Solutions, LLC

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager conducted his own due diligence concurs with the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee, and the Procurement Management Department, to negotiate an agreement with the first ranked respondent, RedSpeed, and if negotiations are unsuccessful, with the next highest ranked firm successively, until an acceptable agreement can be recommended for the City Commission consideration and approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission find it to be in the best interests of the City to accept the ranking of the respondents as specified herein and authorize the Interim City Manager to negotiate an agreement with the first ranked respondent, RedSpeed, and if negotiations are unsuccessful, with the next highest ranked firm successively, until an acceptable agreement can be recommended for City Commission consideration and approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida.

**Section 1.** The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve the following rankings for the RFP as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> RedSpeed
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Altumint
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Blue Line Solutions, LLC

**Section 3.** The Interim City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution, including negotiate an agreement with the highest ranked respondent and if negotiations are unsuccessful, with the next highest ranked firm successively, until an acceptable agreement can be recommended for the City Commission consideration and approval.

**Section 4.** All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 5.** Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and Interim City Manager without further process.

**Section 6.** If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given affect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

**Section 7.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
