RESOLUTION NO. R2024-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MULTIPLE VENDORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER (OEM) AUTOMOTIVE PARTS AND SERVICES IN AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL BUDGETED AMOUNT OF \$200,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER ERRORS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.2 of the City of North Miami Beach Code of Ordinances (“Code”) provides that the Chief Procurement Officer has the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the City would be served.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County issued and awarded Prequalification Pool (“Pool”) Contract No. EVN0000469 “Purchase of OEM/OE Parts, Services and Shop Supplies” to over twenty (20) various dealerships, original equipment manufacturers and authorized repair shops. The Pool is active for a five (5) year term through August 31, 2028 (“County Contract”); and

WHEREAS, this County Contract provides the accessibility and surety of original automotive equipment manufactured products, serviced by trained and certified technicians, and the North Miami Beach Public Works Fleet Division desires to piggyback on the County Contract to facilitate much of its maintenance, repair, purchase, and installation services in an estimated annual budgeted amount of \$200,000.00 (“Piggyback Contract”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-3.14 of the City Code, the City Manager has the authority to approve purchases and awards up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), and any expenditures above this amount need to be presented to the Mayor and City Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve the Piggyback Contract in an estimated annual budgeted amount of \$200,000.00 for the purchase of original automotive equipment manufacturer parts, services, and shop supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission determine it is in the best interests of the City to approve the Piggyback Contract in an estimated annual budgeted amount of \$200,000.00

for the purchase of original automotive equipment manufacturer parts, services, and shop supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Piggyback Contract with various vendors, attached as **Exhibit “A”** for an estimated annual budgeted amount of \$200,000.00, is approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given affect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.




