Agenda Title: Resolution Approving Award of ITB-2025-042 NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue Roundabout Project

Background

The City of North Miami Beach issued ITB No. 2025-042 to select a qualified contractor for the *NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue Roundabout Project*, which aims to enhance roadway safety, improve intersection operations, and provide safe access for pedestrians and vehicles. The selected contractor is responsible for all labor, materials, equipment, permits, and services necessary to complete the project in full compliance with contract requirements while minimizing public impacts and maintaining all safety standards throughout construction.

The solicitation was advertised on the City's website and the OpenGov platform, with electronic notification distributed to more than 35,900 suppliers. On August 8, 2025, the City received ten (10) bids from the following vendors: Arrow Asphalt & Engineering, Inc.; Construction 95 LLC; Florida Blacktop, Inc; Homestead Concrete & Drainage; Maggolo Inc; Quality Paving Corp; Roadway Construction, LLC; The First Community Christian Pentecostal Church of God Inc; and The Stout Group, LLC.

Firms were evaluated based on the solicitation criteria, which included, but were not limited to: possession of valid State of Florida licenses and local business registrations, OSHA 10-hour Construction Safety certifications, at least three (3) successfully completed projects of similar type, size, and complexity within the last two (2) years (with at least two in Miami-Dade or Broward County), and references from owners for relevant projects. This criterion was scrutinized to determine the experience, qualifications and credibility of the bidders. As a result of the evaluation, __ of the 10 firms failed to meet the minimum qualifications. The remaining __ firms were further evaluated based on their proposed pricing and ability to meet project schedules. _____ was deemed the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder. A responsibility review meeting was conducted, and concurrence was received from the City's Public Works Department.
