

RESOLUTION NO. R2025-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF INVITATION TO BID NO. ITB-2025-042 – NE 168 STREET AND NE 20 AVENUE ROUNDABOUT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; AND SUBJECT TO THE BUDGET APPROPRIATION AND AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need for transportation infrastructure improvements to enhance roadway safety and traffic operations through the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City issued an Invitation to Bid No. ITB-2025-042 for “*NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue Roundabout Project*” (the “ITB”), and pursuant to the ITB, the selected contractor is required to provide all necessary labor, equipment, materials, permits and services necessary to complete the project while minimizing public impacts and maintaining all safety requirements throughout construction; and

WHEREAS, the solicitation was posted on the City’s website and OpenGov, with electronic notification sent to over 35,900 suppliers. The City received ten (10) bids from Arrow Asphalt & Engineering, Inc., Construction 95 LLC, Florida Blacktop, Inc., Homestead Concrete & Drainage, Maggolg Inc., Quality Paving Corp., Roadway Construction, LLC, The First Community Christian Pentecostal Church of God Inc., and The Stout Group, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Procurement Management Departments reviewed the bids and conducted a responsibility review meeting, and determined that Maggolg Inc. (“Maggolg”) submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid and recommend award of the ITB to Maggolg in a budgeted amount not to exceed \$224,433; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-3.14 of the City’s Code of Ordinances provides that contracts in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to award the ITB and execute a contract with Maggolg in a budgeted not to exceed amount of \$224,433; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager to award the ITB and execute a contract with Maggolg in a budgeted not to exceed amount of \$224,433 for the successful construction of the NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue Roundabout.

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Commission accept the recommendation of the City Manager and City staff and award ITB-2025-042 NE 168 Street and NE 20 Avenue Roundabout Project to Maggolg Inc., and authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Maggolg Inc., in a budgeted not to exceed amount of \$224,433, subject to budget appropriation and availability of funds.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given affect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
