

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZING PURCHASES FROM THE AMAZON BUSINESS MARKETPLACE, THROUGH AMAZON SERVICES, LLC, D/B/A AMAZON BUSINESS, FOR CITYWIDE PURCHASING OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL MATERIAL AND SUPPLY NEEDS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER'S ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach ("City"), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.2 of the City of North Miami Beach Code of Ordinances ("Code") provides that the Chief Procurement Officer has the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the City would be served.

WHEREAS, Omnia Partners, a national cooperative purchasing organization, through its lead agency Prince William County Public Schools ("*Omnia Partners*") awarded Contract No. R-TC-17006 *Online Marketplace for Purchases of Products and Services* to Amazon Services, LLC dba Amazon Business ("*Amazon*"), through January 18, 2028 ("*Piggyback Contract*"); and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami Beach utilizes the Amazon Business Marketplace for strategically and competitively priced purchases of goods necessary for City administrative and operational materials and supplies, supporting efficiency, sustainability, cost consciousness, and compliant procurement of departmental needs; and

WHEREAS, through its Amazon Business annual membership, the City receives ongoing savings and benefits, including free shipping, rebates, and applicable tax exemptions; and

WHEREAS, the Amazon Business Marketplace includes built-in purchasing controls and guardrails that support compliance with City procurement requirements while enabling participation by small and local businesses through direct marketplace access to City buyers.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-3.14 of the City Code, the City Manager has the authority to approve purchases and awards up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), and any expenditure above this amount needs to be presented to the Mayor and City Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve the use of Amazon Business Marketplace for Citywide purchasing of

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administrative and operational goods, in an annual amount to not exceed \$250,000.00, in accordance with City procurement policies and approved budgetary appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission determine it is in the best interests of the City to approve a Piggyback Contract with Amazon Services, LLC dba Amazon Business for Citywide purchasing of administrative and operational goods through the Amazon Business Marketplace, in an annual amount to not exceed \$250,000.00 in accordance with City procurement policies and approved budgetary appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Piggyback Contract with Amazon Business, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit "A", for Citywide purchasing of administrative and operational goods, in an annual amount not to exceed \$250,000.00, subject to budget appropriation and availability of funds is hereby approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
