

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY AND SMITH EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLY COMPANY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE STREET SWEEPER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$393,145.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach ("City"), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.2 of the City of North Miami Beach Code of Ordinances ("Code") provides that the City's Chief Procurement Officer has the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the City would be served; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell, a national cooperative purchasing organization competitively solicited and awarded Contract No. 062425-FAY *Street and Specialty Sweepers with related Equipment, Accessories, and Supplies* to Fayat Environmental Solutions Americas for a four-year term effective October 24, 2025, through October 27, 2029, with the option to renew for three additional one-year terms ("*Piggyback Contract*"), with Smith Equipment and Supply Company ("*Smith Equipment*") serving as the exclusive Florida dealer for FAYAT street sweepers; and

WHEREAS, the City currently maintains two street sweepers, one of which is aging and in constant need of repair. The City requires an additional reliable street sweeper to support Public Works operations, including roadway maintenance, debris removal, and ensuring clean and safe public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of a second street sweeper will improve operational efficiency, enhance service response capabilities, and support the City's efforts to maintain clean, safe, and well-maintained roadways and public spaces throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-3.14 of the City Code, the City Manager has the authority to approve purchases and awards up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), and any expenditure above this amount need to be presented to the Mayor and City Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve a Purchase Order through the Piggyback Contract in a budgeted amount not to exceed \$393,145.00 for the purchase of a streetsweeper from Smith Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission determine it is in the best interests of the City to approve a Purchase Order through the Piggyback Contract for a purchase order in an amount not

to exceed \$393,145.00, for the purchase of a street sweeper from Smith Equipment and Supply Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Purchase Order with Smith Equipment and Supply Company in substantially the form attached as Exhibit “A”, for the purchase of one (1) streetsweeper in an amount not to exceed \$393,145.00, subject to budget appropriation and availability of funds, is hereby approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener’s or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
