

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PURCHASE ORDER FOR FILTER REHABILITATION SERVICES THROUGH A PIGGYBACK CONTRACT WITH VORTEX SERVICES, LLC; IN A BUDGETED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$271,282.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER ERRORS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, *Florida Statutes* and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.2 of the City of North Miami Beach Code of Ordinances (“Code”) provides that the Chief Procurement Officer has the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans, when the best interests of the City would be served.

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC), a regional governmental cooperative purchasing organization that competitively solicits and awards contracts for use by participating public agencies awarded contract No. TP07-25 *Trenchless Pipeline Rehabilitation Services* to Vortex Services, LLC. effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2029 (Piggyback Contract); and

WHEREAS, filtration is a critical component of the City’s potable water treatment process, removing particles and impurities prior to disinfection and distribution to ensure safe drinking water and regulatory compliance; and

WHEREAS, the NMB Water Department has determined that rehabilitation of potable water treatment filtration systems is necessary to maintain operational efficiency, protect infrastructure, and ensure compliance with drinking water quality standards following inspections revealing corrosion and degradation of Filters #1 and #8 at the Norwood Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-3.14 of the City Code, the City Manager has the authority to approve purchases and awards up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), and any expenditure above this amount need to be presented to the Mayor and City Commission for approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve a Purchase Order through the Piggyback Contract in a budgeted amount not to exceed \$271,282.00 to purchase filter rehabilitation services at the Norwood Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission determine it is in the best interests of the City

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to issue a Purchase Order through the Piggyback Contract in a budgeted amount not to exceed \$271,282.00 for filter rehabilitation services with Vortex Services, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing whereas clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Piggyback Contract with Vortex Services, LLC in substantially the form attached as Exhibit “A”, for a budgeted amount not to exceed \$271,282.00 to purchase filter rehabilitation services for the NMB Water Department, subject to budget appropriation and availability of funds is hereby approved.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
