Agenda Title: Resolution Approving and Authorizing the Award of ITB-2025-059 City Infrastructure Projects – Roadway, Drainage & Related Civil Works to Wrangler Construction, Inc and Metro Express, Inc. as Secondary and Primary Vendors on an As-Needed Basis

Background

The City issued Invitation to Bid No. ITB-2025-059, “City Infrastructure Projects – Roadway, Drainage & Related Civil Works.” Pursuant to the ITB, the selected contractors will provide a range of construction services on an as-needed basis. These services may include, but are not limited to, paving, sidewalk installation and repair, construction, demolition, site preparation, utility work, maintenance of traffic (MOT), sewer and stormwater system construction, and other related civil construction activities, including furnishing all labor, materials, supplies, equipment, tools, transportation, and supervision necessary to perform and maintain the work as described in the scope of services. Expenditures under this contract will be subject to budgeted amounts approved in each fiscal year.

The solicitation was publicly advertised on the City’s website and through OpenGov, with electronic notifications sent to more than 32,250 suppliers. On January 30, 2026, the City received three (3) bids from Wrangler Construction, Inc., Metro Express, Inc., and National Traffic Solutions, Inc. The Procurement Department conducted an administrative review to determine responsiveness of the apparent lowest bidders. The bid tabulation for the two (2) lowest bidders was subsequently forwarded to the Public Works Department for technical review, which determined that Wrangler Construction, Inc. and Metro Express, Inc. are responsible bidders capable of performing the required scope of work.

Based on these findings, the Procurement Management Department, in coordination with the Public Works Department, recommends award to Wrangler Construction, Inc. as the primary contractor and Metro Express, Inc. as the secondary contractor, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidders and in the best interest of the City.

Recommendation

The Chief Procurement Officer recommends that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute an agreement with Wrangler Construction, Inc. as the primary contractor and Metro Express, Inc. as the secondary contractor for an initial three (3)-year term, with an option to renew for two (2) additional one (1)-year terms.

Fiscal Impact
