

RESOLUTION NO. R2026--

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING ATASK ORDER FOR ANNEXATION CONSULTING SERVICES IN A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$85,992, WITH BECKER & POLIAKOFF; UNDER THE “RFQ-24-024-SG LOBBYING SERVICES POOL; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THIS RESOLUTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND SUBJECT TO THE BUDGET APPROPRIATION AND AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 166, Florida Statutes and Section 1.4 of the Charter of the City of North Miami Beach (“City”), the City shall have all available governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers and may exercise them except when prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R2024-89 the Mayor & City Commission approved a pre-qualification list of experienced lobbyist firms and subsequent pre-qualified firms via RFQ-24-024-SG Lobbying Services for a three (3) year term and two (2) one-year renewal terms; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Miami Beach is evaluating the feasibility of pursuing annexation opportunities within Miami-Dade County to enhance municipal service delivery, strengthen the City's tax base, and support the long-term strategic interests of its residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to engage Becker & Poliakoff (“Becker”) for specialized governmental relations and annexation consulting services to assist with stakeholder outreach, coordination with Miami-Dade County officials, preparation and review of annexation-related documentation, public engagement efforts, and the analysis of fiscal, demographic, land use, and service delivery impacts associated with potential annexation initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-3.14 of the Code of Ordinances City of North Miami Beach, Florida, 2008 (Code”) provides that contracts more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee to approve Task Order with Becker in a monthly budgeted amount of \$7,166 for annexation consultation services over the next twelve (12) months; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee to approve Task Order with Becker & Poliakoff in a monthly budgeted amount of \$7,166, not to exceed \$85,992.00 for twelve (12) months of specialized governmental relations and annexation consulting services.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The foregoing clauses are true and correct and adopted as the legislative and administrative findings of the City Commission and made a specific part of this Resolution; all exhibits attached hereto are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Task Order with Becker & Poliakoff for a monthly amount of \$7,166, not to exceed \$85,992.00 for twelve (12) months of specialized governmental relations and annexation consulting services, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit “A,” is approved and the City Manager or designee is authorized to issue purchase orders and execute the Task Order on behalf of the City.

Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to do all things necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Any scrivener or typographical errors that do not affect intent may be corrected with notice to, and the authorization of the City Attorney and City Manager without further process.

Section 6. If any provision of this Resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Resolution that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
