RESOLUTION NO. R2021-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH CURRY CONTROLS COMPANY, FOR SUPERVISORY CONTROL AND DATA ACQUISITION ("SCADA") IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$106,000 FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in line with the City of North Miami Beach's ("City") Strategic Plan of providing excellent municipal services and a high performing City organization providing exceptional water quality, the Public Utilities Department ("NMB Water") provides water service within the City of North Miami Beach, Aventura, Miami Gardens, Sunny Isles and parts of Unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain the NMB Water treatment process and provide water services to customers, NMB Water requires a certified SCADA maintenance contractor to support and provide extensive technical services for the existing SCADA system, which includes but is not limited to, ongoing technical consulting, reporting, testing and inspecting of the system to maintain efficiency, distributing data for smarter decisions, and communicating system issues to help mitigate downtime; and

WHEREAS, the City identifies contracts competitively solicited and awarded by other governmental agencies as a favorable procurement method which is in line with the City's Strategic Plan mission of providing excellent municipal services in a financially responsible manner; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-4.3 of the City's Code of Ordinances allows for the use of other governmental entities' contracts upon a determination that the supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services needed by the City were purchased using solicitation procedures which are substantially equivalent to the City's Purchasing Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, St. Johns County, Florida, issued Request for Proposals No. 17-79-02 in December 2017, for qualified SCADA service providers for technical services and support. Award of this RFP was made to Curry Controls Company ("Curry Controls") under Master Contract #18-MCC-CUR-08942, effective January 23, 2018, for an initial contract term of three (3) years with one (1) three-year renewal option; and on September 18, 2020, St. Johns County exercised the renewal term for three (3) year through January 22, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-3.14 of the City's Code of Ordinances provides that contracts in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be awarded by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, the NMB Water Director and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the City Manager or designee

to enter into an agreement with Curry Controls for certified SCADA maintenance services in an estimated budget amount not to exceed \$106,000 for three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission believe it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the City Manager or designee enter into an agreement with Curry Controls Company for certified SCADA maintenance services in an estimated budget amount of \$106,000 for a three (3) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Commission of the City of North Miami Beach, Florida:

Section 1. Recitals Adopted. The aforementioned recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Agreement Approved. The agreement with Curry Controls Company, in substantially the form attached as Exhibit "A," for certified SCADA maintenance services in an estimated budget amount of \$106,000 for a three (3) year term (the "Agreement") is approved.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager or designee is authorized to enter into an agreement and take any action necessary to implement the Agreement and the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
