- A. Act as the legal advisor for the City and all of its officers in all matters relating to their official powers and duties.
- B. Prepare or review all ordinances, resolutions, contracts, bonds and other documents in which the City is concerned, and shall endorse on each his/her approval of the form, language, and execution.
- C. Prosecute or defend, for and in behalf of the City, all complaints, suits and controversies in which the City is a party, before any court, or other legally constituted tribunal.
- D. Attend all meetings of the City Commission.
- E. Recommend to the City Commission for adoption, such measures as he/she may deem necessary or expedient.

POSITION PROFILE

The ideal candidate has a track record of success and is a dynamic and innovative leader whose attributes encompass being ethical, a team player, a proactive attitude, excellent problem solving skills, and tactfulness in handling sensitive/delicate matters.

The individual will partner with the Commission and City staff to solve problems while being a supporter and a trusted advisor. He/she will understand the political environment but not be involved. Regular and honest communication is expected at all times with the Commission, City Manager and City staff. Similarly, he/she must be an outstanding leader and mentor of the staff.

The individual will thrive on solving problem strategically. The ideal candidate will be someone who reviews an issue with an open mind and, when applying the law, then aggressively seeks ways to accomplish what is best for the City and its residents.

When asked a question, he/she will know the correct answer and respond accordingly. When the individual does not know the answer, he/she will say so and provide the requested information in a timely manner.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

As per City of North Miami Beach Charter, the City Attorney or law firm shall be a member of the Florida Bar with at least five years' experience in the practice of law in Florida, and with limited applicability to the City Attorney (not the law firm) shall not, during his/her tenure of office, engage in any private practice of law.

The ideal candidate has ten (10) years of increasingly responsible experience in management and the practice of law (preferably municipal).
